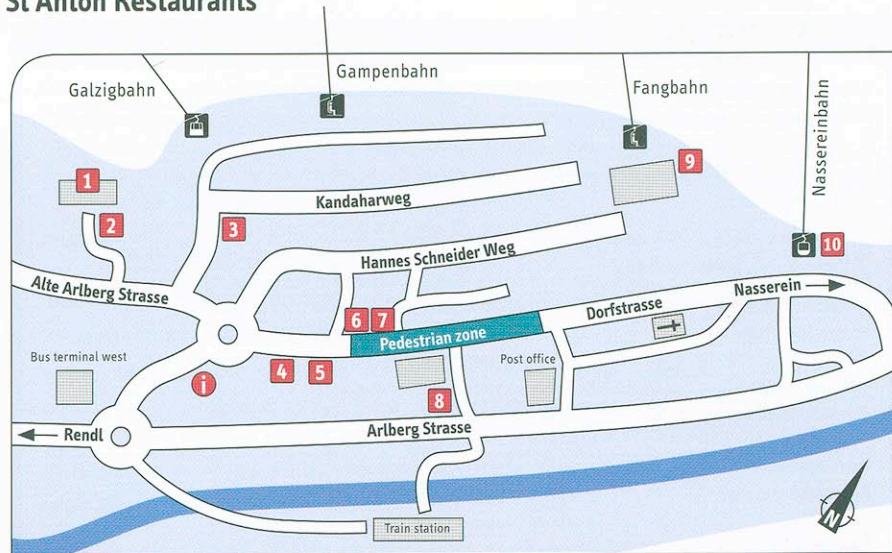

### How to read our reviews:

Resort restaurants and bars (page 107) are listed in alphabetical order. Unlike with mountain restaurants (page 121), we only include details of those places we recommend.

-  – budget: most main course prices are under €10
-  – mid-range: main course prices range from €11-20
-  – expensive: most main course prices are €20+
-  – reasonable vegetarian choice
-  – venues that close late (1am or after)
-  – our absolute **Mad Dog** favourites. These are the places that our researchers return to time and time again; sometimes for their classic mountain feel, sometimes for their warm welcome, sometimes for their budget prices and sometimes because they're perfect for a treat.
